Brain-injured man wins jury verdict

ABERDEEN – Evan Sullivan of Mize won a \$2.9 million jury verdict Thursday in U.S. District Court from his lawsuit against United Parcel Service Inc.

Sullivan received severe brain injuries in 2006 when he fell onto the pavement from his utility bucket after it was struck by a UPS tractor trailer in Southaven.

The two-week trial before Senior Judge Glen H. Davidson ended after one hour's deliberation, said Sullivan's attorney, William M. Quin II of Jackson, formerly of Tupelo.

Sullivan still has problems with his thinking, caused by brain hemorrhages more than three years ago.
